Maintenance of Traffic Bulletin #84 **October 24, 2003**

NIGHTTIME LANE CLOSURES ON STATE ROAD 953/NW 42nd AVENUE (LEJEUNE ROAD)

Commencing Monday, October 27, 2003 through Thursday, November 6, 2003: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, two northbound lanes and two southbound lanes on **LeJeune Road between NW 25 Street and NW 26 Street** will be closed **weeknights, from 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M.** These lane closures are due to the installation of an underground conduit by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc (Mastec North America). **This work will be performed during weeknights and will be divided into phases in order to lessen the impact on the traveling motorists.** Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place to detour traffic.

Phase I and II (Intersection of SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 25th Street): During **Phase I**, the two right Northbound lanes and right turning lane on SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 25th Street will be temporarily closed. Traffic will be shifted to the left northbound travel lane. During **Phase II**, the left northbound lane, left southbound lane and left southbound turning lane on SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue and NW 25th Street will be temporarily closed. Northbound and Southbound traffic will be shifted to the outer lanes. Vehicles traveling on the southbound left turn lane at NW 25th Street will need to turn left at NW 27th Street or use the on-ramp to NW 21st Street to go eastbound. In addition, vehicles traveling westbound on NW 25th Street to go northbound onto LeJeune Road will need to be detoured through NW 26th Street and back onto northbound LeJeune Road.

Phase III (SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) Southbound from NW 26th Street to NW 25th Street): The two right southbound travel lanes on SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue from NW 26th Street to NW 25th Street will be temporarily closed. Southbound traffic will be shifted onto the left southbound lane.

Phase IV (Intersection of SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 26th Street): Two left northbound lanes and two left southbound lanes (including the left turning lane) will be temporarily closed at the intersection of SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 26th Street. Northbound and southbound traffic will be shifted to the outer travel lanes.

Phase V (Intersection of NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 26th Street): Two right northbound lanes will be temporarily closed at the intersection of SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 26th Street. In addition, NW 26th Street from NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 39th Avenue will be temporarily closed to thru traffic.

Intersection of State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 14th Street

Tuesday, October 28, 2003: The westernmost southbound lane and right turn lane on NW 14th Street and 42nd Avenue from about 200 feet North of NW 14th Street to NW 14th Street will be **temporarily closed from 8:00 PM to 12:00 Midnight**. Two Southbound lanes will remain open. This closure is due to drainage improvements for the NW 14th Street Construction Project. This work will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place to notify commuters.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.*
