CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Closure of Northbound Lane on NW 39th Avenue from NW 21st Street to NW 25th Street

Commencing Tuesday, November 4, 2003 through Thursday, November 6, 2003: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, the northbound lane on NW 39th Avenue from NW 21st Street to NW 25th Street will be temporarily closed. Airport vehicular traffic and traffic coming from NW 21st Street will not be permitted to turn left onto N.W. 39th Avenue. Northbound traffic on NW 39th Avenue should go straight and follow the detour signs on NW 37th Avenue. This closure is due to the installation of a gravity sewer system for the MIC Rental Car Facility. **Crew working hours will be during non-peak hours from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Utilities). An off-duty police officer will be on site and Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of lane closures.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Full Road Closure of the Intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street and Temporary Ramp Closure for Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue

Commencing Friday, November 7, 2003 at 9:00 p.m. until Saturday, November 8, 2003 at 7:00 a.m., the intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed. This temporary closure will be necessary for the installation of the new drainage system at this location. Local businesses and residential access will be maintained on the affected roadways. Southbound thru traffic on NW 37th Avenue should turn left at NW 14th Terrace, turn right at NW 34th Avenue, go straight until NW 11th Street and turn right to go back onto NW 37th Avenue. Northbound thru traffic on NW 37th Avenue should turn right at NW 11th Street, turn left at NW 34th Avenue, go straight until NW 14th Terrace and turn left to go back onto NW 37th Avenue. In conjunction with this road closure, the westbound SR-836 exit ramp on NW 37th Avenue will be temporarily closed. Motorist on Westbound SR-836 should keep right and use the next exit on NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). **Crew working hours will be from 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.** This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of detours and intersection closures. Only Emergency Vehicles will be provided access through this closure.

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Construction Activity No. 3:

Change in Traffic Patterns on NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street

Commencing Saturday, November 8, 2003 through Sunday, November 16, 2003: The two southbound lanes along NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road), from approximately 100 feet north of NW 14th Street to NW 13th Street, will be temporarily closed. Southbound traffic will be shifted to the northbound lanes. One lane in each direction will be maintained open to traffic. In addition, the southbound left turn along NW 37th Avenue onto the SR-836 East on-ramp will also be temporarily closed. Southbound traffic should follow detour route to NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to go East onto SR-836. The lane closures are due to drainage and roadway improvements along this intersection. **Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. Variable Message Signs (VMS) signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.*
