CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Partial Closure at the Intersection of NW 25th Street and NW 39th Avenue

Commencing Saturday, November 22, 2003 through Sunday, November 23, 2003: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, the southeast side of the intersection of NW 25th Street and NW 39th Avenue will be temporarily closed. Flagmen will be on site to divert traffic flow around the work zone. Lane closures will be in effect from **Saturday, November 22 at 7:00 a.m. to Sunday, November 23 at 5:00 p.m.** This closure is due to the installation of a gravity sewer system for the MIC Rental Car Facility. Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Utilities). An off-duty police officer will be on site.

Construction Activity No. 2:

NW 21st Street from NW 39th Avenue to NW 37th Avenue:

Commencing Saturday, November 22, 2003 through Sunday, November 23, 2003: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, lane closures will occur on NW 21st Street from NW 39th Avenue to NW 37th Avenue. The eastbound and westbound lanes will be merged to one lane in each direction between N.W. 37th Avenue and N.W. 39th Avenue in order for the vehicular traffic to be diverted around the work zone. Lane closures will be in effect from **Saturday, November 22 at 7:00 a.m. to Sunday, November 23 at 5:00 p.m.** This closure is due to the installation of the water main system.

Construction Activity No. 3

Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) Project: Construction of an Additional Westbound Lane From SR-112 to Okeechobee Road Off-ramp

DATES: November 24, 2003 to December 1, 2003

MAINLINE: As part of the improvements to SR-112, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on westbound SR-112 between NW 32nd Avenue and Okeechobee Road from **Monday, November 24 to Wednesday, November 26, 2003.** These closures will be during the non-peak hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Also, westbound on SR-112 at the NW 37th Avenue bridge, up to two lanes will be closed from **Monday, November 24 to Wednesday, November 26.** One lane will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and the second lane will be closed from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Additionally, on westbound SR-112, at the NW 37th Place Bridge, one lane will be closed from **Tuesday, November 25 to Wednesday, November 26** between the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Motorists should look out for roadway detours.
