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### **24-HOUR FULL RAMP CLOSURE OF MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT'S (MIA) EXIT RAMPS #2 AND #3 TO SR-112/NORTHBOUND LEJEUNE ROAD FROM EASTBOUND NW 21 ST. (CENTRAL BLVD)**

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Miami-Dade County, Florida: **Commencing Friday, September 14, 2007 at 10:00 P.M. through Friday, November 2, 2007 at 5:00 A.M. (24 hr. continuous closure): MIA's Exit Ramps #2 and #3 onto SR-112/Northbound LeJeune Road from Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) will be completely closed.**

**Detour Route for MIA Exits #2 & #3: Motorists will need to follow the posted detour signs on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn left and continue north until NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, turn left and continue to LeJeune Road and turn right to continue in the Northbound direction.**

During this period, the **On-Ramp to Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street from Southbound LeJeune Road will also be closed to allow for continuous traffic flow exiting Miami International Airport and construction of the new on-ramp.** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour signs as outlined below:

**Detour Route for On-Ramp to Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street: Southbound traffic on LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) should turn left on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, continue east until NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) and turn right, continue south until NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street and turn left to continue on east NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street. All traffic wishing to go to the Hertz Car Rental, Tri-Rail Airport Station, Wyndham Hotel, MDX and Tropic Supply will need to turn right at NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street.**

These 24-hour closures are required for safety reasons during the demolition of the existing bridges and are necessary to continue with the construction of the new bridges for the exit ramps to the future Miami Intermodal Center and LeJeune/SR-112 from Central Boulevard (NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street), and are being expedited in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public.
