**CORRIDOR BEAUTIFICATION OF  
SR-953/LEJEUNE ROAD (NW 42<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE)  
FROM SR-836 TO NW 28<sup>TH</sup> STREET  
BEGINS JUNE 2, 2008!**

**Miami-Dade County, Florida – On June 2, 2008,** contractors for the **Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District VI**, will begin the LeJeune Road Landscaping Project. This effort is part of Miami Intermodal Center’s Program and the Department’s continued commitment to “preserve the quality of our environment and communities”. Approximately \$4.7 million dollars worth of landscape materials, decorative treatments, new irrigation and lighting system will be installed in the median and along both sides of LeJeune Road between SR-836 and NW 28<sup>th</sup> Street.

This work should take approximately 16 months to complete. We ask for your patience and cooperation while this work is underway since planting and other project-related work might require closing travel lanes during non-peak hours (9:00 A.M. to 3:30 P.M. and/or 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M.). Access to businesses will be maintained at all times. Please note, however, that this schedule is tentative and might be impacted by bad weather and other unforeseen circumstances. Motorists might experience delays when traveling through this area. Please be assured that every effort will be made to minimize the impacts this work might have on traffic in this busy area.
